Feedback on weekend procedures

- Numbers for our first two weekends back have been around 200 for each weekend's liturgies.
- Things seem to be running smoothly, with policies and procedures being followed successfully.

Overview of end of fiscal year parish finances: Dan Hansen

- A balanced budget has been submitted for 2020 - 2021
  - Expenses have been cut mostly through personnel as discussed last meeting
- COVID-19 initially caused some concern with offertory giving, but has since rebounded and is on par with last year.
- St. Mary borrowed about a half million dollars under the Payroll Protection Plan. This is a forgivable loan as discussed last meeting.
- Pledges from St. Mary families are up and overall the deficit for 2019 - 2020 is not as big as was projected.
- Our tuition policy has changed. We now have a member parishioner rate of tuition and a non-parishioner rate. In order to receive the parishioner rate, you must be registered and make a pledge. The suggested minimum pledge is \$1000.

Revised directives and timeline for implementation from Archbishop ListECKI

- a. Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals: attendance can be up to 50 people (including ministers, volunteers)
- b. Reconciliation: we are looking at two weeks yet until reconciliation starts. It will not be face-to-face.
- c. Weekday masses: up to two weekday masses per week may have live attendance. These will not begin until after July 4th.

Pastoral Council terms and selection of new members

- Discernment of new members will be pushed back later than August

Trustee term and election

- Clem Budney will continue to serve as trustee until wider parish elections can take place
