The Racial Justice Committee met on June 8, 2022. It continues to find ways to help people understand better racism, racial justice as outlined by Catholic Social teaching, and white privilege. A trip to the Black Holocaust Museum in Milwaukee is planned for July 16, 2022.

Two professors from UWM (Thomas Malaby PhD, and Jill Budny PhD) are writing a curriculum and leading a course for interested folks to study Racial Justice. The five Monday evenings for these sessions start on June 20 in the evening. The class is limited to 8 people.

In March, 13 people attended a Book Study on racism reading the book, "How the Word is Past" by Clint Smith. In the Autumn, a JustFatih series on Racial Justice is planned beginning in September.

Synodal Church

October 10, 2021, Pope Francis convened a universal synod called "For the Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission". He asked to hear from everyone around the world within a two year period of time. Through listening and dialogue sessions within each diocese, Pope Francis hopes to discover the dreams and visions of the people in order to seek the Holy Spirit so that the Church might flourish in the future. The Synod will end with an International gathering in Rome of all Bishops in August of 2023.

The USCCB is gathering information from the US dioceses and compiling it and looking for trends and themes. Our Archdiocese is looking for responses from Feb-June 2022.

After all is said and done, Pope Francis will write an apostolic exhortation in order to shed light on what is discussed in the Synod from what was gleaned from the people.

Fr. Aaron and Jeff Kacala will discern together what the next step might be for St. Mary in terms of gathering information for the Synod.
