# Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes 05-08-25 St Mary Catholic Faith Community Hales Corners, WI

Approval of Pastoral Council Minutes: Deferred to next month.

Parish Festival Outreach: Dave Lownik stressed the need for volunteers and chairpeople. The festival has over 1000 slots (volunteer opportunities) for 3 days, including setup and teardown. Current volunteers are aging out. The ask is for everyone to spread the word regarding the need for volunteers, or sign up yourself. Areas where help is really needed: soda, kid games, bingo, mostaccioli dinner, garbage cleanup, and finance (it's the finance person's last year in this role). We should explore getting the youth of the parish involved, such as Boy Scouts. The website for volunteers is open. Father Aaron asked the Liaisons to allot time during their next meeting to discuss the festival. One suggestion: have the Pastoral Council take on Mostaccioli for Saturday? To that point, Jim will check to ensure there is still a need.

#### **Liaison Reports:**

#### Finance:

Brenda said they met on 3/12/25. They spent time on the 2025-2026 budget, which is currently \$4 million. They are projecting a slight (2%) budget deficit at this point, due to a smaller enrollment than we had hoped for. Staffing needs include a Marketing Coordinator and Associate Pastor. May be able to make up for deficit with the Special Needs Scholarship Program, offertory increases, or an uptick in enrollment. There are adequate reserves to cover this slight deficit.
